## Talk to your baby in the womb using an iPhone, Ritmo pregnancy system

releas ed the Ritmo Advanced Pregnancy Sound System, which lets you use an iPhone or iPod for safe sound to prenatal listeners.

Ritmo can connect to most audio devices with a universal stereo plug—such as iPods, iPhones, MP3 players, and Blackberries. An expectant mother wears this lightweight belt around her belly. The belt has four speakers and a controller, which fits into a pocket.

Her audio player plugs into the controller, which utilizes Nuvo's patented Safe & Sound Technology to regulate output to a safe level for a baby to hear in-utero, regardless of how loud the sound was recorded or the volume that it is played.

Research shows reactive listening begins at 17 weeks gestation. Often referred to as the Mozart Effect, numerous studies show that music contributes positively to human fetal development, bonding and stress reduction.

With Ritmo, sound that can be delivered in-utero has expanded beyond music to include voice through the phone. This enables the entire family to bond through communication, even from distant locations, according to the folks at Nuvo Group.
